Interested researchers must obligatorily belong to one of the country's University institutions. They can apply for the Fund's support by presenting their application file before **January 31, 2024** at the latest.

The documents must be written in English, and will include:

- > a **brief presentation** (3 pages maximum) of the intended research. If applicable for the project, it will be submitted for approval to the Committee of Ethics.
- > if there are, related references of articles published by the author(s);
- > a short C.V.
- > a detailed budget (incl. VAT) required by the project.  
If relevant, specify alternative financing.

The application file will be sent to the Fund exclusively by electronic mail to [eliane.fourre@hart-chirurgie-cardiaque.org](mailto:eliane.fourre@hart-chirurgie-cardiaque.org). They will be examined by the Fund's Scientific Council. Selection will be ended for **March 31, 2024** and the authors will be immediately informed.
